| <p>All empty packaging that is not made of paper or glass = lightweight packaging (LWP)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Please separate packaging components from each other, e.g. remove lid and throw in loose - Rinsing not necessary - Do not stack one inside the other <hr/> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Milk and drinks cartons - Yogurt and cream pots - Pasta bags - Mustard tubes - Cereal bar wrappers - Food cans - Plastic trays and films for food - Packaging films - Filling material of postage packaging e.g. bubble wrap, Styrofoam® - Cleaning and detergent bottles - Shampoo bottles - Spray cans - Bottle caps | <p>Empty disposable glass packaging</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Rinsing not necessary - Lids do not have to be unscrewed - no crockery, no porcelain, no drinking glasses, no window glass <hr/> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - All non-returnable glass bottles, e.g. for wine, sparkling wine, spirits, vinegar, oil, milk, juices - Small glass bottles, e.g. perfume bottles - Jam, pickle and mustard jars - Other glass packaging for fruit, sauces, soups, vegetables | <p>Paper, cardboard, cardboard boxes</p> <p>Please flatten cardboard boxes, e.g. fold them or tear them up</p> <hr/> <p>Packaging made of paper, cardboard or cardboard boxes such as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Bakery bags - Egg boxes - Filling material of shipping cartons made of paper, cardboard, cardboard boxes - Flour and sugar bags - Paper carrier bags - Boxes of chocolates <p>Non-packaging materials made of paper, cardboard, cardboard boxes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Letters - Envelopes - Books - Wrapping paper - Catalogues - Magazines - Newspapers | <p>Organic waste</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Wrap in newspaper, paper bags or throw in loose - DO NOT use (compostable) plastic bags! - Throw food in bin WITHOUT packaging! <hr/> <p>Kitchen waste</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Leftovers (raw and cooked) - Cheese, meat, sausage and fish leftovers - Bread and bakery leftovers - Fruit and vegetable waste - Citrus waste - Coffee filters and tea bags - Egg and nut shells <p>Sanitary papers</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Paper kitchen towels - Paper towels - Paper napkins <p>Garden waste</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Grass, leaves, herbaceous waste - Plants, potting soil, small rootstocks - Tree and hedge cuttings | <p>Best avoided</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Disposable masks - Disposable gloves - Cigarette butts - Nappies - Sweepings - Hoover bags - Porcelain, ceramics - Wallpaper remnants - Mirrors - Broken toys - Music and video cassettes - Cat litter - Hygiene products such as cotton pads, cotton buds, wet wipes - Dishwashing sponges and cloths |
