New guidelines for separating recyclable materials from 1st January, 2022





PACKAGING









All empty packaging that is not made of paper or glass = lightweight packaging (LWP)

- Please separate packaging components from each other, e.g. remove lid and throw in loose
- Rinsing not necessary
- Do not stack one inside the other
- Milk and drinks cartons
- Yogurt and cream pots
- Pasta bags
- Mustard tubes
- Cereal bar wrappers
- Food cans
- Plastic trays and films for food
- Packaging films
- Filling material of postage packaging e.g. bubble wrap, Styrofoam®
- Cleaning and detergent bottles
- Shampoo bottles
- Spray cans
- Bottle caps

GLASS

Empty disposable glass

- Rinsing not necessary

- Lids do not have to be

no drinking glasses,

no window glass

- All non-returnable

glass bottles, e.g. for

wine, sparkling wine,

spirits, vinegar, oil,

Small glass bottles,

e.g. perfume bottles

Other glass packaging

milk, juices

- Jam, pickle and

PAPER







Paper, cardboard, cardboard boxes

Please flatten cardboard boxes, e.g. fold them or tear them up



BIOWASTE









Organic waste

- Wrap in newspaper, paper bags or throw in
- DO NOT use (compostable) plastic bags!
- Throw food in bin WITHOUT packaging!



RESIDUAL WASTE









Best avoided

Packaging made of paper, cardboard or cardboard boxes such as:

- Bakery bags
- Egg boxes
- Filling material of shipping cartons made of paper, cardboard, cardboard boxes
- Flour and sugar bags
- Paper carrier bags
- Boxes of chocolates

Non-packaging materials made of paper, cardboard. cardboard boxes:

- Letters
- Envelopes
- Books
- Wrapping paper
- Catalogues
- Magazines
- Newspapers



Previous FLACH bin will remain on-site and will become a paper-only bin.

Kitchen waste

- Leftovers (raw and cooked)
- Cheese, meat, sausage and fish leftovers
- Bread and bakery leftovers
- Fruit and vegetable waste
- Citrus waste
- Coffee filters and tea bags
- Egg and nut shells

Sanitary papers

- Paper kitchen towels
- Paper towels
- Paper napkins

Garden waste

- Grass, leaves, herbaceous waste
- Plants, potting soil, small rootstocks
- Tree and hedge cuttings

- Disposable masks
- Disposable gloves
- Cigarette butts
- Nappies
- Sweepings
- Hoover bags
- Porcelain, ceramics
- Wallpaper remnants
- Mirrors
- Broken toys
- Music and video cassettes
- Cat litter
- Hygiene products such as cotton pads, cotton buds, wet wipes
- Dishwashing sponges and cloths
